t	tennis/tennis	Turn head from side to side as if watching tennis and say t, t, t.
m	mmm/manger	Rub tummy as if seeing tasty food and say Mmm.
i	ink /souris	Pretend to be a mouse by wriggling fingers at end of nose and squeak i, i, i.
I	lick/lèche	Pretend to lick and envelope or lollipop and say I, I, I.
c k	castanet/casta	agnette Raise hands and snap fingers as if playing castanets and say ck, ck, ck.
e	me/je	Point to yourself and say je, e, e, e. In English say me, e, e e.
n	no/non 1	urn head and make a sign with your finger pretending to say no, n, n, n.
r	roar/rugir F	Pretend you are a lion roaring r, r, r.
d	down/descendr	e Raise arms high and pretend to come down stairs moving fingers and say d, d, d.
ο	ocean/océan	Move hand in circular movement like waves in the ocean and say o, o, o.
р	puddle/pluie	Move fingers like rain coming down making a puddle and say p, p, p.
u	/pu	Pinch your nose and say u, u, u, prending there is a bad odour.
g	gurgle/glouglou	ute Spiral hand down, as if water going down the drain, and say g, g, g.
f	freeze/froid	Rub hands and arms pretending to be freezing and say f, f, f.

Jolly Phonics Alphabet and Actions

- **b** bat/baton Pretend to hit a ball with a bat and say b, b, b.
- j juggle/jongler Pretend to be juggling balls and say j, j, j.

qu quack/caqueter Make a duck's beak with your hands and say qu, qu, qu.

- van/voiture Pretend to be holding the steering wheel of a van and say v, v, v.
- z zigzag/zigzag Move hands doing zigzags pretending to be a bee and say z, z, z.
- **y** yogurt/yaourt Pretend to be eating a yogurt and say y, y, y.
- x x-ray/rayon-x Pretend to take an x-ray of someone with a camera and say xs, xs, xs.
- h huff/haleine Hold hands in front of mouth panting as if you are out of breath and say h, h, h in English. Do not say anything in French.
- **w** wagon/wagon Pretend to pull a wagon and say w, w, w.
