Please find attached the next batch of <u>words</u> for our **sentence program**. The <u>subjects</u> are on white paper and the <u>objects and complements</u> are on green paper. <u>Verbs</u> are on red paper and <u>prepositions</u> are on yellow. Please cut and place in labeled color-coded baggies. At school, the children are starting to do their <u>reading booklet</u> full of acceptable sentences. When brought home, the booklet can be placed into their special reading bag / box or shelf and read along with the previous booklets.

After your child has made a sentence, she/he can explain what their sentence means, showing comprehension of what their sentence is about.

The children should now be able to make sentences like the examples below: (You may use Halloween words of because we are starting later in the year simply exchange for Christmas subject and objects—white and green words).

Un **chat noir** mange avec une **sorcière** à la **maison hantée**. Un **fantôme** vole avec une **chauve-souris**.

Also, please help your child understand the words *dans* (in), *sous* (under) and *sur* (on).

Un **squelette** tombe *dans* la maison hantée.

Un squelette tombe *dans* une **citrouille**. (Not acceptable as this does not make sense.)

The verb *écoute* does not need a yellow card. This means *listens to*. A sentence might be:

Une araignée écoute un monstre.
